GCBO at Work

Our mission is met by our research, conservation, and education projects, and your support makes that possible! Here is a short review of a few of our many programs.

Avian Research Projects

We have been staying true to our mission by investing much of our efforts in the field doing necessary avian research to find the issues facing birds today. Not just on the Upper Texas Coast but all along the Gulf of Mexico. Our team of biologists and partners have found ground breaking data about American Oystercatcher's nesting island degradation, Eastern Willet wintering ground locations, and Black Skimmer nesting sensitivities, just to name a few out of so many projects.



Land Conservation Projects

GCBO's Land Acquisition Fund and the Tropical Forest Forever Fund are contributing to major land acquisitions across the Gulf states and in Latin America. To date \$745,226 have been granted to help purchase 27,262 acres in 11 countries on 34 projects. The funds are continually being built to help even more into the future!



Education Projects

A new focus for 2020 will be the constant threat of balloons and fishing line along our coast lines. We have rescued countless birds and hope to help educate about this danger. We hope that one day we will not have to rescue entangled birds!!
