ELIGIBILITY

Artists of all ages are welcome! There will be four entry categories: Elementary School, Middle School, High School, and Adult. Please specify which age group you fall into. Submissions will be limited to one entry per person, twenty entries per school (teachers may judge before submitting).

JUDGING AND WINNERS

Judges will choose one winner, second place, and third place artwork from each age group. Judging will be blind, so please sign artwork on the **back** with your name, entry group, age, school (if applicable), contact phone number, and piece title. Top ten pieces from each age group will be mounted and put on display. Pieces that do not will be returned to artists.

Prizes:

Elementary: 1st place gets a birding book and a bird feeder Middle School: 1st place gets a birding book and \$20 High School: 1st place gets a birding book and \$30 Adult: 1st place gets a birding book and \$30

Artwork Requirements

All mediums and design colors are welcome, but we request that pieces be submitted on 8.5X11 inch paper. Winning pieces will be mounted, so leave at least one-inch border around the art.

Winning designs may be converted into a limited color palette design for printing GCBO T-shirts or merchandise. Designs will become property of GCBO.

All artwork must be completely original and produced by the student.
