SUBMISSIONS

Eligibility:

Artists of all ages are welcome! Submissions are limited to one entry per person, due to limited space.

All artwork must be completely original and produced by the artist or artists

Artwork Requirements:

All mediums are welcome, so long as the pieces aren't too heavy/large to be placed on folding tables. Art can consist of photography, sculpture, painting, drawing, fiber arts, and whatever else you can think of! GCBO will not be mounting or framing the pieces, so please submit all art in the form you wish it to be displayed in.

When submitting, please include name, medium, title, and a short description of the piece. If you wish, you may include an asking price to be posted with the piece and contact information for buyers.

Please note that while the exhibit building will be locked at night, it will be open to the public during the day and no staff will be looking after the art.
